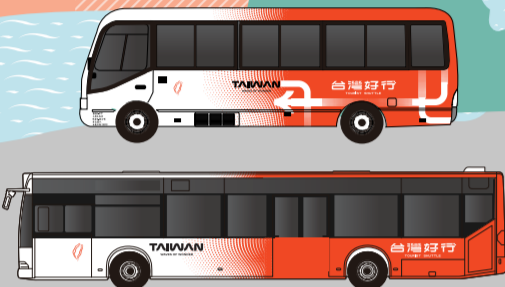

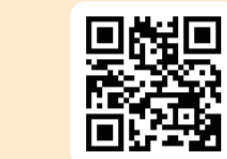

(11) Taichung Midtown Bus Loop operates in both counterclockwise (Right Loop) and clockwise (Left Loop) directions, and departs from either Taichung Station (Minzu Intersection), traveling counterclockwise, or from Taichung Station (Chenggong Intersection), traveling clockwise.

**679 Taichung Dynamic Coast Route Seaside Getaway Route**

- Dajia Station (Zhongshan Rd.)**: Dajia Jinn Lann Temple, Dajia Jinn Lann Night Market
- Gaomei Wetland (Sanshulu Rd.)**: Gaomei Wetland
- Taichung Aquarium**: Centered around Taichung's hydrological ecosystem, this aquarium takes visitors on a journey "from Taichung's rivers to the world's oceans", offering experiences in both ecological conservation and entertainment.
- Wuqi Fishing Port 1**: Enjoy the freshest seasonal seafood, embark on a yacht tour, or take stunning photos with the 3D murals that make you feel like you're undersea.
- Taichung Harbor Passenger Service Center**: Blending marine tourism, fashion, and entertainment, this is Taiwan's first harbor-style shopping mall. Its 60-meter-tall "Taichung Star" Ferris wheel is a popular landmark.
- Wuqi (Chaoyan Temple)**: It's Taiwan's first historic site guesthouse, featuring Japanese-style houses and kimono wearing experiences. Stroll along the old street, and visit century-old temples. Don't forget to try the famous savory cake and mullet roe.
- Taichung Blvd.-Zhongshan Road Intersection**: The Wings of Shalu. Taichung International Airport is located in Shalu, where must-try dishes are meatballs, duck meat, meatball soup, pineapple shaved ice, starfruit juice, and tofu-based desserts. Grab some jerky as souvenirs!

**Tour Recommendations**

**888 Fengyuan-Houli Route Explore Fengyuan & Houli**

- Mazu Temple**: Mazu Temple has a long history and serves as a spiritual center for locals.
- Dongfeng/Houfeng Bicycle Path**: Once a railway, this is now one of Taiwan's most popular cycling routes. The scenic trail passes Houli Equestrian, Tunnel No. 9, the Huallung Iron Bridge, and the Dajia River.
- Houli Horse Farm**: Dating back to the Japanese colonial era, this is Taiwan's largest and most historic public horse ranch. Featuring heritage sites and equestrian performances, it's a favorite family-friendly destination.
- Yuewei Sugar Factory**: It's a century-old sugar factory with Taiwan's only chimney tunnel. Enjoy traditional popcicles and guided tours that reveal the history of this industrial heritage site.
- Lihpao Land**: It's an all-in-one entertainment paradise featuring Taiwan's tallest 120-meter Ferris wheel, dual-theme parks for land and water adventures, and a five-star resort.
- Zhongshu**: Spanning 6 hectares in Houli, known as the "Town of Flowers", this park offers a prime spot for observing rare bird species. The forest offers a tranquil experience immersed in nature.

**889 Dasyueshan Route Travel Along Leisurely at Dasyueshan**

- Shigang Dam**: The upper reaches of the Dajia River form a large lake at Shigang Dam. Whether viewed from afar or up close, the scene presents a different and stunning landscape.
- Dongfeng Bicycle Green Way**: Stretching 13.6 kilometers, the Dongfeng Bicycle Green Way is Taiwan's first bike path built on an old railway track. Rent a bike and enjoy a ride connecting The Lingtan Platform and the Dongshi Hakka Cultural Park.
- Lovers Wood Bridge**: Lovers Wood Bridge is Taiwan's first wooden bridge constructed without any supporting piers. It holds the record for the longest span of any landscape wooden bridge in the Far East.
- Liyubing Park (Far Outbound Only)**: Converted from the old Dongshi Railway Station, the park exhibits the rich heritage of Hakka culture. Behind it is the Dongfeng Bicycle Green Way. At Dongshi District Image Commercial District, egg-filled pancake rolls, dumplings, beef dishes, and noodles are must-eat foods.
- Dasyueshan backdoor**: In the 1960s, this area housed the largest timber factory in East Asia, and today, it's a unique park that combines wood sculpture and ecological aesthetics, preserving the valuable timber industry heritage.
- Henglingshan Trail**: The Henglingshan Trail was originally used to transport timber. The route is rich in diverse ecosystems, surrounded by beautiful forests—ideal for nature walks suitable for all ages.
- Tourist Center**: Dasyueshan boasts Taiwan's richest biodiversity, and its viewing platform is a prime spot for observing rare bird species. The forest offers a tranquil experience immersed in nature.

**11 Taichung Midtown Bus Loop Have fun at Midtown**

- Taichung Station**: Taichung Station Railway Cultural Park, Taiwan Connection 1808/Lyuchuan Canal
- Siang Shang Junior High School**: Taichung Station features a unique blend of three generations of stations—old, new, and modern, bearing witness to the station's century-long history.
- Calligraphy Greenway (Citizens Square)**: The Taiwan Connection 1908 is an elevated garden transformed from an old railway track.
- Calligraphy Greenway (Park2)**: Stroll along the Lyuchuan Canal, and feel the Japanese Charm of Kyoto.
- National Museum of Natural Science/Botanical Garden**: Shen Ji New Village is a creative cultural base, beloved by social media influencers for its picturesque spots.
- Yizhong Shopping District**: The Green Ray Renovation Plan consists of 12 old dormitories, blending fantasy, art, and creativity.
- Taichung First Senior High School**: Calligraphy Greenway, ranging from National Museum of Natural Science to National Taiwan Museum of Fine Arts, creates a vibe, compact and peaceful like the cursive writing of Chinese calligraphy. Don't miss the Taichung Jazz Festival every October.
- Yizhong Shopping District**: The museum is Taiwan's first science museum. It has a diverse variety of exhibitions. The vast rainforest greenhouse in the Botanical Garden is a landmark.
- Taichung First Senior High School**: Centered around Yizhong Street, it's a must-visit spot for street food and trendy shopping. The handmade stinky tofu, Japanese crepes, fried chicken cutlets, and Feng Ren Rice are must-eat foods.
- ShowTime Cinemas**: Taichung Sugar Factory Taichung Office is a renovated historical building, where quaint architecture meets the tranquil lake, perfect for a stroll.

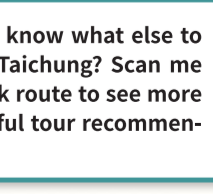

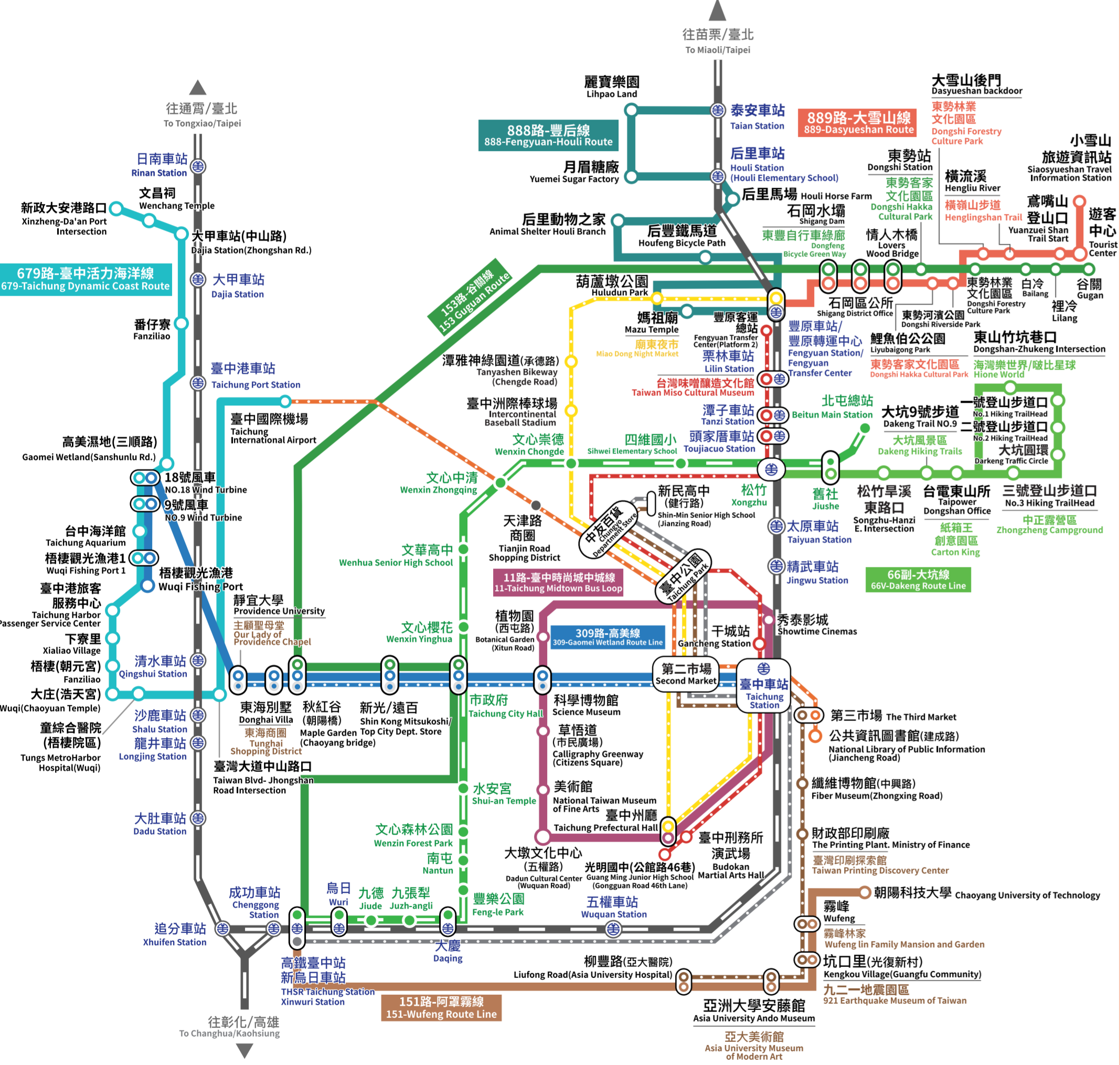
