Route 1

- 2 Hanxi Riverside Bikeway / Haitian Bridge**
The bikeway runs alongside Hanxi and includes the distinctive pure white "Haitian Bridge." Cyclists can admire the spectacular sight of golden shower trees in May and June.
- 1 Nanxing Park / Mickey Tree**
The renowned "Mickey Tree" is a popular spot for taking photos for social media. The park features a roller skating rink, bike paths, and expansive lawns. Visitors can also admire the bald cypress trees in November.
- 3 Lunch \ Beiping Rd. Food District**
- 4 Taichung Central Park**
Constructed with a focus on technology, low carbon footprint, and innovation, the park boasts twelve interactive installations, offering a high-tech experience unlike any other park.
- 5 Taichung Central Park Visitor Center Shuinan Airforce 1**
The ground floor of the visitor center is designed to look like a real airport terminal and tarmac, complete with an authentic aircraft cabin, allowing you to enjoy the experience of flying without needing to purchase a ticket!
- 6 Taichung Green Museumbrary**
The building's exterior wall resembles a thin veil, showcasing a sense of natural transparency. Combining an art museum and a library, it has become a new cultural landmark in Taichung.
- 7 Dinner \ Feng Chia Night Market**

Route 2

- 9 Wenxin Forest Park**
The park's Fulfillment Amphitheatre serves as an open-air venue for artistic and cultural events. It also includes a spacious sandbox, a roller skating rink, and hillside trails, making it a favorite spot for families.
- 8 Fengle Sculpture Park**
The sculptures are situated throughout the park and its large ecological pond, blending art with nature. There is also a rare parkour practice area.
- 10 Dinner \ Gongyi Rd. Food District**
- 11 Calligraphy Greenway**
The greenway stretching from the National Museum of Natural Science to the National Taiwan Museum of Fine Arts features different markets on holidays and is a popular stage for street performers.
- 12 Maple Garden**
This attraction includes a lake, lawns, a scenic bridge, and a charming family of black swans. Verdant by day and beautifully illuminated at night, it is an ideal spot for family walks and romantic outings.
- 13 Dakeng Hiking Trail No.9, 9-1**
Dakeng boasts 14 hiking trails. Trails no.9, 9-1 are particularly gentle and easy to walk. From the observation deck, hikers can enjoy sweeping views of the city and a refreshing and uplifting experience.
- 14 Dakeng No.9 Night Market**
The newest night market right next to Dakeng No. 9 Trail. Soak up mountain views by day, then dive into tasty street food after dark. It's the perfect combination for travelers seeking nature and flavor in one trip.
- 15 Dinner \ Zongzhan Night Market**

Route 1

- 16 Yide Mansion**
The mansion blends elements of traditional red-brick three-sided courtyard residence, military dependents' villages, Japanese architecture, and two-story Baroque-style Western houses. It offers modern Taiwanese cuisine and hosts occasional exhibitions and cultural events for visitors to enjoy.
- 17 Taichung Military Kindred Village Museum**
Previously named "Beitun New Village," it was initially a residential area for Air Force and their families. It has been transformed into a museum, restaurant, and grocery store, offering a glimpse into the vibrant culture of military dependents' villages.
- 18 Taiwan Folk Museum**
As the first folk park in Taiwan, this cultural museum is a traditional Minnan-style building. It showcases antique furniture, folk arts and crafts, and traditional toys, providing an educational and entertaining experience.
- 19 Lunch \ Beiping Rd. Food District or ShuinanMarket**
- 20 Taichung Hub**
Situating inside the Taichung City Hall, it presents Taichung's urban development, cultural uniqueness, and future outlook through four key themes: Vision, History, Urban Affairs, and Life. Visitors can enjoy the exciting 5D theater to immerse themselves in the beauty of Taichung.
- 21 National Taichung Theater**
Designed by Japanese architect Toyo Ito, it revolves around the concept of "Acoustic Holes," characterized by distinctive elements like curved walls, holes, and tube-like structures. It's also a trendy spot for photography enthusiasts.
- 22 Dinner \ Jingming Shopping Arcade or Gongyi Rd. Food District**

Route 2

- 23 Historical Wuri Police Station**
Once serving as a police officer during the period of Japanese rule, this building reflects the distinctive wooden architectural style prevalent at the time. It continues to be used today as the office of the Wuri Police Station.
- 24 Wan He Temple**
Regarded as a grand monument, this temple emanates a profound sense of historical and cultural heritage. It proudly upholds the tradition of "Surname Drama," a legacy spanning almost two centuries, thus standing as a significant folk cultural asset.
- 25 Lunch \ Nantun Old Street**
The quaint old street is adorned with ancient houses and traditional shops, ranging in age from five or six decades to over two hundred years. Visitors can also savor the unique summer dessert exclusive to Taichung, known as jute soup.
- 26 Nantun Jute Art Culture Museum _Litudian**
This museum delves into the historical and cultural development of the former Li-Tou-Dian area (now Nantun District), highlighting the production of jute rope and the tradition of consuming jute soup. Alongside artifact displays, visitors can experience hands-on activities.
- 27 Shen Ji New Village**
The historic dormitory complex has been a breeding ground for innovative brands such as ingenious dessert shops, cafes, boutique stores, and markets. Its retro ambience exudes a cultural allure.

3 **Beiping Rd. Food District**
The extensive stretch between sections 3 and 4 of Beiping Road is lined with a diverse array of street food stalls, offering a multitude of flavors. Noodle dishes, in particular, are a favorite among foodies.

10 Gongyi Rd. Food District
This top food district in Taichung is home to numerous Michelin Guide-listed restaurants, offering a wide variety of cuisines, including Taiwanese, American, Japanese, and European, for you to enjoy.

15 Zongzhan Night Market
Easily accessible and just a 2-minute walk from the MRT station, this night market is ideal for grabbing a meal or dinner, providing a perfect ending to a day trip via the MRT.

19 Shuinan Market
Spanning a vast area, this traditional market offers an abundance of culinary delights and features many well-known old-time street foods, including Dongshan duck heads and fried noodles, drawing foodies from near and far.

22 Jingming Shopping Arcade
The street features an array of boutiques, tea and coffee houses, international restaurants, and art galleries, and the area's sidewalks and outdoor cafes boast a European charm. Additionally, it was one of the locations of the Taiwanese film *The Pig, the Snake and the Pigeon*.

29 Changping Rd. Leather Shoes Shopping District
During its early days, this district was renowned as Taichung's premier hub for handmade shoes. Today, their meticulous craftsmanship of Taiwanese-made goods remains a hallmark of quality, drawing in numerous visitors who enjoy exploring and discovering treasures here.

30 Tianjin Rd. Clothing Outlet of Taichung
Mainly focusing on wholesale merchandise, this place offers products like clothing, accessories, bags, and shoes. During Chinese New Year, it is also a must-go shopping place for the local community.

31 Daqing Night Market
Featuring more than 250 stalls and excellent planning for traffic flow, parking, and restrooms, this large night market is perfect for those seeking genuine and budget-friendly street foods.

32 Maple Honest Store
The store offers eco-friendly products produced by the community and Nantun jute foods. Uniquely, it operates without staff, relying on customers to place their payments into the "honesty jar."

7 Feng Chia Night Market
Renowned as the largest night market in Taiwan, it is famous for its street foods like small sausage in large sausage, fried noodle buns, and takoyaki, attracting visitors from near and far. It is also the origin of many creative street foods.

- Electronic Ticket**
- Single-journey tickets are available for purchase at all MRT stations.
 - Swipe the electronic cards such as EasyCard, iPASS, and iCash at the entrance gates and to enter the station. Top-up services are available at all stations.
 - Electronic tickets can be purchased at Passenger Agent Office in MRT stations or convenience stores.
 - Please visit the Taichung MRT official website for more information on ticket types and fares.
 - Use Youbike app to rent bicycles without registration at all MRT stations to make your trip more convenient!
